Following the welcome in room L3, mentors will go to their respective tables - each mentor will be allocated a table in either room L4, L5 or L6 (see below) and will be provided with a large monitor to connect to their laptops for their presentations.

Participants have previously selected their preferred discussion topics and each will be given a personalized list of which tables they will attend for each of the 4 timetabled discussion groups (this will be emailed to participants prior to the congress and will also be provided as a print out on the day). Participants will rotate around the mentor tables in 40 minute blocks.

The symposium will end with a short wrap-up in L3 with each of the mentors saying a few words about their discussion groups.
